With Oenology and Viticulture qualifications from The University of Adelaide, Nav also holds a Bachelor of Management from the University of South Australia. He has comprehensive knowledge of many different winemaking styles and techniques and has gained wide industry experience throughout Australia and Burgundy, including positions

at Mountadam, Chandon Australia, Haselgrove and three vintages at Domaine de L'Arlot in France. Navneet strives for excellence and aims to craft wines of distinction, which stand above all others in their quality and provenance. His focus is on showcasing the unique regionality of the Australian wine landscape while providing a path to future sustainability and growth. Since his appointment to Moss Brothers in 2005, the young gun has brought a new wave to the Margaret River region where he has been awarded numerous accolades for his wines, winning five trophies and over eighty wine show medals. Having completed the AWRI Advanced Wine Assessment Course in 2006, Nav has judged at the Hyatt Advertiser South Australian Wine of The Year Awards, the 2007 Macquarie Commonwealth Bank Margaret River Wine Show and the 2008 Qantas Western Australian Wine Show. A regular panelist with Peter Forrestal and John Jens, he also undertakes tastings for Scoop Magazine WA. While studying winemaking in his youth, Nav spent four years working as Sommelier for Hyatt Regency Adelaide. It was here that he gained his grounding in the great wines of the world and was three times awarded South Australia's Best Wine List in the Tucker Seabrook Wine List of the Year Awards.
