The virtually unknown Windows Estate on Caves Road at the Northern end of Margaret River is a 5000-case winery that has received significant show acclaim and laudatory reviews.

The wines are produced with the assistance of the very affective viticultural contractor and winemaking consultant Mick Scott.

The stand out in the range is the 2008 Cabernet Sauvignon. It is clean, well made and carefully oaked for a wine in this price range. Drink this now as while there are fine and persistent tannins, they are not aggressive, thus leaving a lingering, easy finish. It won a silver medal at the London International Wine Challenge.

This shows serious quality pristine Cabernet fruit that is good enough for you to grab a case.
